Dear Parents and Carers,

It's been a brilliantly creative week at school! I was thrilled to see the creativity in Bumblebees during our Virtues Assembly on Tuesday - I'd like to say a big THANK YOU to children and staff for sharing their inventions 'Pea Traps', boats, planes and presents that were a joy to share and explore with them.

Our Chair of Governors Revd Sian Yates has been impressed throughout her Community Assemblies by the older children's curiosity, empathy and creative thinking. Your children are engaged in their learning and school community in a way that is a credit to you and Pensans School.

Today the Government has issued updated guidance regarding Covid 19 which you will find below:

- children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend
- adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days

We have a **48 hour rule** before children can attend school following an episode of **diarrhoea and vomiting**; we will have a **3 day (72 hour rule)** for children to return following a positive **Covid** Test result.

The school will continue to follow good hygiene protocols of hand washing, ventilation and cleaning frequently used surfaces.

As I told you in a previous newsletter we are sadly saying goodbye to John Tallon next week. I am sure that you will join me in thanking him for the contribution the he has made to the school and wishing him good luck in his new job.

Thank you to Sam and the PTA for organising the Easter Raffle and Egg Hunt! In the Summer Term with better weather and the change in Covid guidance I am really looking forward to many more sociable school events and REAL Project outcomes.


