

Dear Parents, Carers & Families

Well after a great start to the week with attendance being at 95%+ I was so disappointed when it dropped to 88% on Friday. I cannot re-iterate enough how important it is that your child attends school 5 days a week! I realise children get tired quickly at the beginning of term, getting back into busy school life, however, together we must build the children's stamina so that weekly events such as swimming and after school clubs do not affect your child's attendance. It is a shame that already some children will be playing catch up with the work they have missed. Our new attendance strategy will be focussing fortnightly on pupils with broken weeks in school. Hopefully everyone is now getting back into home/school routines and this will improve next week J (Lookout for the Pensans Attendance Strategy in key information on the website)

Thank you for helping us to establish the new drop off and pick up points with the children. From Monday you will notice that there will be areas to the front of the school cordoned off by the contractors who are beginning work on the new Area Resource Base (ARB)This will be a specialist education provision. These works will be continuing for approximately 8-9 weeks so please ensure you supervise your children when arriving and leaving school. School staff will also be outside at the beginning and end of the school day to help.

As our extra –curricular clubs start and school trips begin it is even more important that parents make sure they have signed up to theARBOR App and Parent Portal. Remember this is now our primary source of communication with you. Any problems please do ask in the office for help.

This week three classes will enjoy trips out to Penlee museum: Godrevy and Gwithian classes to learn about Victorian Toys and Porthcurno Class to enhance their study of the Stone Age. We also will be sharing some exciting news about a Y5/Y6 residential planned for July 2024! Mr Rutterford will be sending out information next week to parents of children in Sennen Class. 

The safeguarding of our children and school community is intrinsic and integral to all that we do at Pensans. In the everchanging online world that we all live in, Online Safety is and will continue to be kept high profile within the tapestry of our everyday learning and teaching at Pensans.

This week, it is top tips about sharing photos of your children appropriately.

Back to school photos

With the excitement of a new school year and your child reaching a new milestone, many of us share photos of our child online without thinking about the associated risks. If you post online, then try following these basic rules:

• Don't post any photos of your child that show their school logo/name or recognisable places by where they live that can make it easy for people to find out their location.

• Never include your child's full name.

• Are there any other children in the pictures you share online? If yes, do you have permission from their parent/carer to upload it?

• Would your child be happy for your comment/photo about them to be online – remember what might be 'cute' now may be embarrassing to them in the future.

Make sure appropriate privacy settings are on.

Alternatively, you could just share photos with those who you really want to share the photo with (grandparents etc.) via WhatsApp or iMessage rather than via social media.
