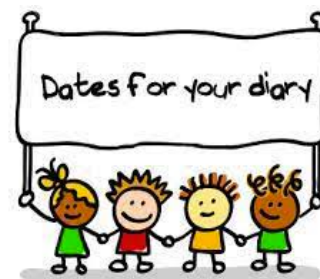

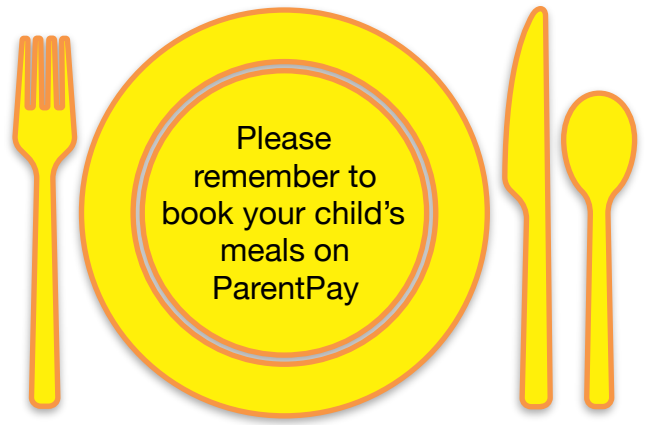

I am Sancha, a year five pupil at Pensans Primary School. Me and my class are learning about Sudan and how hard it is for the people who live there to survive. I am writing to you to ask for donations to help us raise money for a well to be built in Sudan, but we can't do it without your help. Just think how much better their lives will be with clean water.

Have you seen the horror, sadness, fear and misery in their eyes? An intelligent person like yourself shall know that we have to give them a chance to live a good life like we do. The real truth is about 92% of the population in Sudan is drinking contaminated water from unimproved water sources. In my opinion it is not okay to have to live like that, don't you agree?

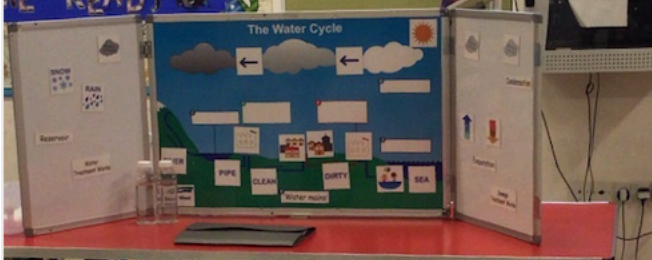
Butterflies Easter Bonnet Parade



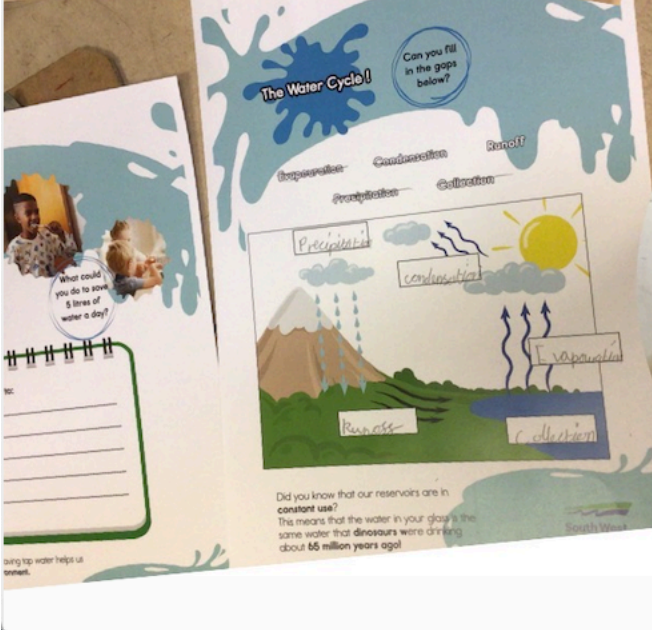
