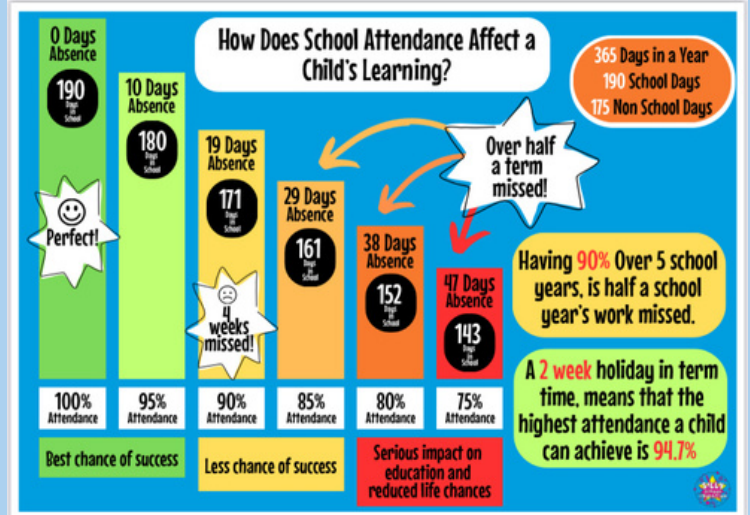

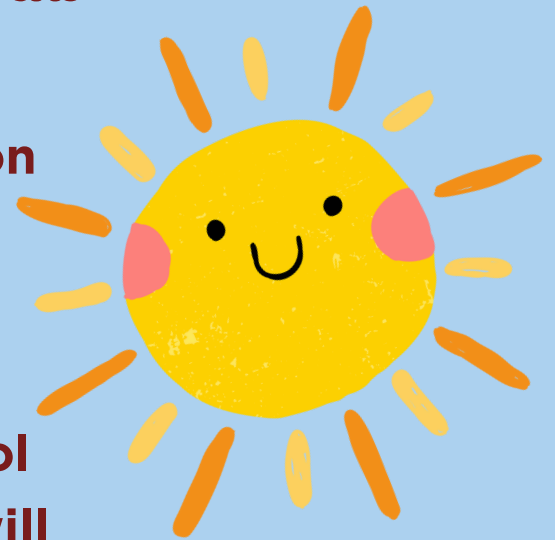
Attendance Matters





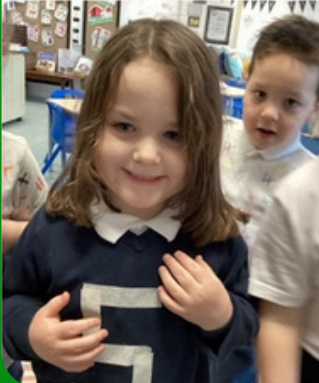
