Can you...?

give items that can be moved;

picnics, trains, buses

transporting people

draw maps

follow roads

rotation

rolling and being spun round, playing with wheeled toys, watching the washing machine



Can you...?

roundabout circuits,

roll with rolling pins

explore cogs

water wheels

connection

joining furniture with wool or ribbon , joining train tracks together, sticking boxes and models together

connecting trains

magnets

explore different types of knots

building/construction

positioning
