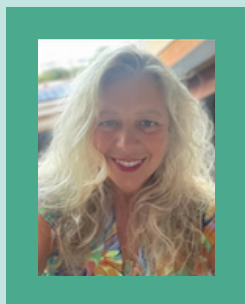

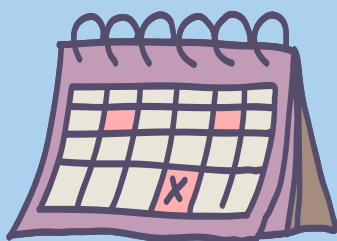

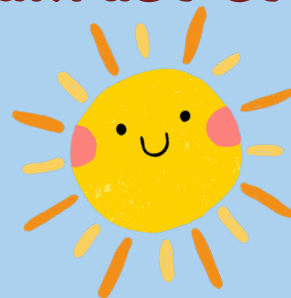
Return to School on Tuesday 5th November 8:40am
