




As part of recognising outstanding learning behaviours, we will be celebrating the children who have achieved **BLUE** each week. Well done to everyone who achieved it this week!

Phase 1 - Green and Orange

Drop off - 8.50am

Phase 2 - Cobalt and Amber

Drop off - 8.40am

Pick Up - 2.40pm

Indigo Class has been creating Ubuntu art patterns. We used a lined drawing for inspiration and used art pencils to experiment with shading and texture.








