I am delighted that after half-term we will be able to offer before and after school care - initially for children of working parents. Our in-house before and after school care will be run by Miss Trudgeon, please email messages@pensans.cornwall.sch.uk if you would like a booking form for your child.

- Before school care sessions will begin at 8.00am and children will have access to games etc in the hall. Breakfast will be given to children in their classes at the beginning of the school day as it is currently not in the club.
- After school care (PARC) will be available until 6.00pm Monday to Thursday and 5.00pm on Fridays. Please email messages@pensans.cornwall.sch.uk if you would like a booking form for your child.

We are also able to offer a number of Go Active clubs from 9th June for 7 weeks to working families. We are able to offer Gymnastics to Y1/2/3s, Nerf Gun Club to Y4/5s and Street Surfing to Y6s. 

If you think your child may be entitled to "Free School Meals" please email Mrs Oliver in reception (messages@pensans.cornwall.sch.uk) This also applies to those having free dinners because they are in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and have "Universal Infant Free School Meals" because of their age. This is especially important if your child is currently in Orange Class (Year 2) as from September these children will not be eligible for free meals just because of their age. You will need to apply if you think you are eligible because of your income.

Our school also receives Pupil Premium funding for each child on Free School Meals so as well as helping you, it also helps our school.
