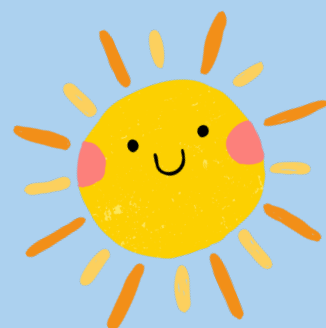


Breakfast Club

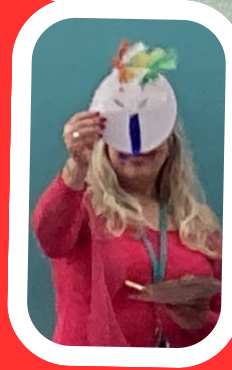
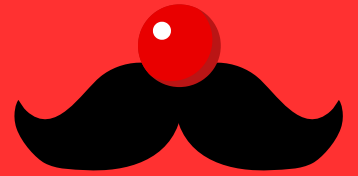

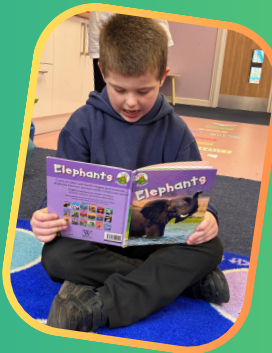
